Registration Fees

The Registration fee is made up of two components:

1. A deposit of six week's tuition fees refundable upon leaving the school provided the school account is up to date. The refundable deposit must be in line with how many days your child attends school and what class they are in and will be invoiced accordingly

2. A non-refundable school development fee of R1000

This fee is charged per child and not per family and is payable once upon enrolment.

There is a Registration fee refund policy detailed in the Terms and Conditions of Enrolment.

Daily rate (until 12:30pm) of R100 for babies and R120 for toddlers and pre-schoolers

All tuition fees include art, music and physical education. In addition, Grade R and Primary School includes Mini-Chess®

Fees are payable in advance before the 5th of every month and are payable for 12 months

All fees include a SAMA¹ and ISASA¹ child levy

Primary school fees include one outing per term

The school day starts at 8am and ends at 12:30pm in the Preschool and 2pm in the Grade R and Primary school, except on Fridays when school finishes at 1pm

Annual Levy

Annual fees go towards the enhancing of the teaching and school environments and teacher training, supplies for the children to use during school time and projects identified by school management.

The Annual levy is charged per child and payable in two halves – the first half in March and the second half in August.

General Information

- Discounts are given for termly or annual payment of fees – please enquire finance@carnegiehouse.co.za
- All overdue accounts will be charged a penalty fee of R150 if not settled by the 5th of the month
- There is a 10% discount on school fees for a second and third child.
- The *ad hoc* rate for aftercare will be charged to your account if children are collected late.
- All fees are payable irrespective of absences for illness, leave etc. Fees during your holidays are fully payable.
- It is the responsibility of the Parent/s to familiarize themselves with the late collections policy as well as the Debtor's Policy as detailed in the Parents Handbook available on www.carnegiehouse.co.za/admissionandenrolments.html
- For security reasons, we do not accept cash for the payment of school fees. Please use EFT or debit order.
- Bank cash deposit fees for cash deposits into the school bank account will be charged to the child's account.
- Please use your child's name or account number as reference on all EFT, debit order or direct payments.
- Termination of enrolment at Carnegie House Independent School is **one full month** in the Preschool and **one full term** in the Primary school.
