## Tuition Fees –payable for 12 months

All tuition fees include art, coding, computer literacy, enrichment activities and physical education in the primary

Fees are payable in advance before the 5<sup>th</sup> of every month and are payable for 12 months. Please stipulate on your enrolment form how you will be paying the monthly tuition fees. All fees include a SAMA<sup>1</sup> and ISASA<sup>2</sup> child levy.

#### **Registration Fees**

The Registration fee is made up of two components:

- 1. A <u>refundable</u> deposit amount of R4500 on entry into the Primary school.
  - 2. A <u>non-refundable</u> school development fee of R1500.

This fee is charged per child and not per family and is payable once upon enrolment. There is a Registration fee refund policy detailed in the Terms and Conditions of Enrolment.

#### Annual Levy

Annual fees go towards the enhancing of the teaching and school environments, teacher training, supplies for the children to use during school time and projects identified by school management.

#### Additional Costs

- School text books that your child needs textbook lists are sent out at the end of the year and text books must be available on the first day of school.
- Children's text books that the school orders added to your monthly account
- Eisteddfod and Olympiad fees
- Sports equipment such as tennis racquets and hockey sticks
- Special outings, annual class camp fees or guest speakers.
- Any extramurals or extra sport activities and all outings

### **General Information**

- The school opens at 7:30 am and classes start at 8.30am
- The school day ends at 2:15 pm in the Primary school except on Fridays when school finishes at 1.30pm.
- All overdue accounts will be charged a penalty fee of R150 if not settled by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month
- There is a 10% discount on school fees for a second and third child.
- All fees are payable irrespective of absences for illness, leave etc. Fees during your holidays are fully payable.
- It is the responsibility of the Parent/s to familiarize themselves with the late collections policy as well as the Debtor's Policy as detailed in the Parents Handbook.
- Bank cash deposit fees for cash deposits into the school bank account will be charged to the child's account.
- Please use your child's name or account number as reference on all EFT, debit order or direct payments.
- Termination of enrolment at Carnegie House Independent School is strictly one **full term** in the Primary school.
